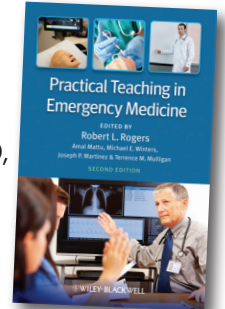
- more sessions on educational technology
